

Position regarding the exploitation of worker, human trafficking and slavery

Exploitation of workers, human trafficking and slavery do not have room in our supply chain. We particularly set focus on this at supplying raw materials.

All bio-familia suppliers are obligated to meet the social ethical minimum standards in the production. Especially child labour and all forms of compulsory labour are forbidden, which break the basic rights of human beings.

Thanks to our long-term partnerships, we have a good relation basis and work transparency over the whole supply chain. We support the BCSCI-initiative with our membership to meet the social ethical requirements and audit ourselves with the social ethical standard (SMETA or WCA).

Sustainability is very important especially with strategic raw materials. We are as well co-founder of the "Happy-Hazelnut"-project, to support a social and sustainable hazelnut farming. Most of the processed organic raw materials are certified after the Bio Suisse-standard, where social ethical aspects have to be fulfilled. With the Bio Suisse-acknowledgement, we organise the Bio Suisse sustainability check.

With in-house and external trainings, we ensure that our standards are held.

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
